## FLYING YOU ONLY LEARN BY FLYING

Not by watching or by studying theory books. But by actually doing it. Personal growth always takes place beyond our comfort zone. The problem is not the error, it's the chain of errors. Because no one speaks up or no one matters about given feedback. The team makes the difference. Make sure you have people on board telling you what you need to know, not what you want to hear!





## CONFIDENCE IS THE FUEL FOR SUCCESS

---

Crews switch roles on every flight - „Pilot Flying“/„Pilot Monitoring“. Give everyone in your crew the chance, to take responsibility and to make survivable mistakes. In aviation the learning is: strong teams don't need steep hierarchies to perform, but clear roles with individual empowerment and changing perspectives. That doesn't make a leader less important, but it enables a leader to be a mentor and to mentally stay ahead of the airplane.



## YOU CAN'T PULL OFF THE ROAD...

---

Being a pilot means being responsible. Don't try to find the right decision. Make good decisions and therefore make use of your inner compass. There is no autopilot for the important decisions in life. In the long term, a wrong decision is always better than no decision. Being a pilot is always better than being a passenger.
